





Roadie™ Set Up

WARNING: ALWAYS FOLLOW PROVIDED INSTRUCTIONS. USE ONLY UNDER SAFE CONDITIONS. NO UNSUPERVISED CHILDREN. USE WITH CAUTION. THE ROADIE™ HAMMOCK STAND MUST BE SET UP ON A FLAT, LEVEL SURFACE THAT WILL SAFELY SUPPORT THE ROADIE AND ITS OCCUPANTS BEFORE USE. CHECK FOR WEAR AND DAMAGE BEFORE EVERY USE. ALWAYS ENSURE CAR IS IN PARK, PROPERLY POSITIONED WITH THE EMERGENCY BRAKE EMPLOYED BEFORE SETTING UP YOUR HAMMOCK. DANGER: USING THE ROADIE OTHER THAN AS DIRECTED MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

CAUTION: The Roadie™ is not appropriate for every vehicle. Your vehicle's wheelbase (the distance from the center of the back wheel to the center of the front wheel) must meet or exceed 7'10" and curb weight (the weight of an automobile without occupants or baggage) must exceed 2,500lbs. Check the owner's manual.

ASSEMBLY:

1. Find a flat and level surface to park your car and set up your Roadie™. **WARNING:** Do not use your Roadie™ if your vehicle is on an incline. Once a suitable location has been determined, place your Roadie™ base plates in front of each tire - touching the tire. It is strongly recommended that the vehicle is turned off or is in park with the parking brake employed before setting the base plates in front of each tire to avoid injury. **NOTE:** The base plates have a FRONT & REAR designation - the pole sockets should be aimed up and away from the vehicle in V shape (see illustrations on reverse). Tires must be positioned over the textured strips on the bases.
2. **CAUTION:** Ensure base plates are clear of any objects and any person in the area is safely away from the vehicle and hammock stand before driving over the Roadie™. Although you can set up your Roadie™ by yourself, a friend is encouraged to help guide the set up process. Slowly and carefully drive your vehicle onto the base plates, placing the vehicle in PARK and taking your foot off the brake to allow it to rest comfortably on the base plates. **NOTE:** It is normal for the bases to lift a bit during installation/removal.
3. Insert the upright poles into the base sockets, sliding the top piece into the bottom first. **NOTE:** Poles are interchangeable and can be used for either front or rear.
4. The Roadie™ comes with an Atlas Roadie™ Suspension System. After attaching the Atlas Roadie Suspension System to the base using the hooks, take the multiple-loop end of the straps and run it over the upright pole caps, inserting into the slit and ensuring it is completely seated in the caps and not bound or twisted. **NOTE:** Never attempt to use the Roadie™ without the support of the Atlas Roadie™ Suspension System. Always check for wear and tear of the suspension system before use.
5. Once you make sure your hammock is in good condition and can support the weight of the users, clip the hammock to the desired loops in the straps using the hammock's carabiners. Adjust if needed to achieve your preferred hanging position. **NOTE:** Always test the hammock before getting in to ensure an accurate set up. Lay back, and relax...

CAUTION: Maximum weight capacity of the ENO Roadie™ shall not exceed 250 lbs.

DISASSEMBLY:

1. Remove your hammock from the Atlas Roadie™ Suspension System.
2. Pull the Atlas Roadie™ Suspension System up and out of the slots of the pole caps.
3. Remove poles from the sockets and place away from the vehicle's wheels and any other traffic, both vehicular and pedestrian.
4. **WARNING:** Ensure that the area is clear of people and objects before driving off the bases. **NOTE:** Removal can be done in either forward or reverse. Extreme care must be taken to perform this task in a SLOW & CONTROLLED manner. Roll the vehicle forwards or backwards until the tires roll over the edges of the base plates and onto the level ground. **NOTE:** It is normal for the bases to lift slightly during installation/removal. It is strongly recommended that the vehicle is turned off or is in park with the parking brake employed before picking up the base plates to avoid injury.

If ENO is held liable to Customer because (i) any Roadie™ is claimed to be defective, deficient, improperly manufactured, or otherwise insufficient in any manner, or (ii) Customer incurs any other costs, liabilities (directly or to third parties), damages or detriment, Customer's remedy therefore shall be limited to a refund of the purchase price of the Roadie™ at issue. ENO shall be subject to no other liability to Customer of any type or nature whatsoever by virtue of any obligation founded in contract, tort, strict liability, indemnity, contribution, or otherwise. (This paragraph does not afford Customer any right to a refund but constitutes only a limitation of remedy in the event liability is otherwise established.)

Indemnity. In the event of any third-party claim, demand, lawsuit, arbitration, or investigation ("Claim") asserted or commenced against ENO arising out of or in any way connected with Customer's negligence, gross negligence, willful misconduct, or any other misuse of any Roadie™ of any nature whatsoever, Customer will defend, indemnify and hold harmless ENO from any and all liability, damages, costs, and other detriment in connection with such Claim, and Customer will pay as incurred the attorney's fees of counsel of ENO's choice for defending such Claim.

Waiver, Covenant Not To Sue. Customer hereby waives all rights against ENO except as set forth herein and covenants not to institute any action or proceeding against ENO as a result of (i) any alleged defect, deficiency, manufacturing imperfection, or insufficiency in any Roadie™ or (ii) any other costs, liabilities (directly or to third parties), damages or detriment.
